



Student Grant Funding FAQs

Application Period:	Fall - October 1 st through November 15 th Spring - February 15 th through March 31 st
Notifications Made:	Fall - December Spring - April (via email to all applicants whether they are being funded or not)
Awards Funded:	January and May
Wish Categories:	Educational, Extracurricular, Leadership or <i>Anahi Dance Award</i> (choose one)
Nominators:	Must be a professional in education, social work, law enforcement, housing, recreation or coaching within the four county area (Sacramento, Placer, El Dorado, Yolo) familiar with the student or family being nominated and willing to make a financial contribution or a donation of time to help support <i>The Wish List Project</i>
Nominees:	Must be residents of the four county area; preference will be given to at risk youth/teens, single parent families, foster youth, low income families, developmentally disabled youth/adults, and families with an incarcerated parent
Requirements:	Completed application with contact information must be provided; a photo and signed photo release will be required of the nominee (or nominee's guardian) within 14 days if selected as a grant recipient; A written thank you note sharing the impact the <i>Wish</i> had on the nominee will be required after it is funded
Restrictions:	Basic needs requests will not be considered; Nominee may receive funding only once in a two year period; All decisions of <i>The Wish List Project</i> Selection Committee are final
